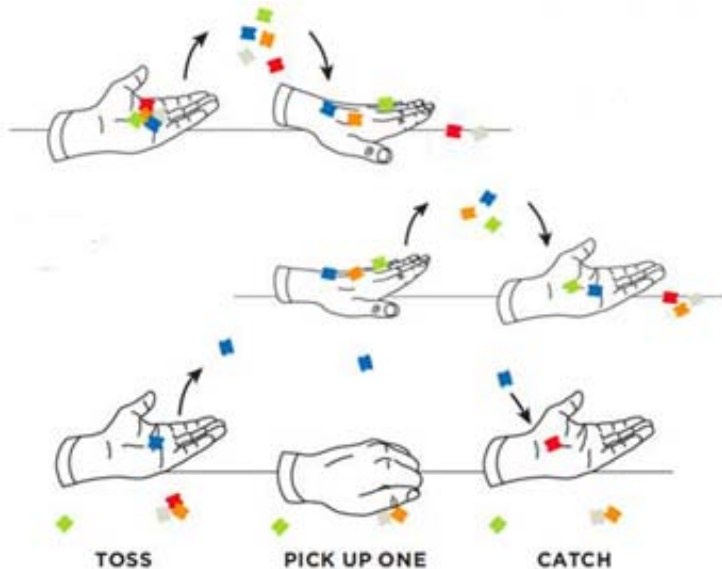


Funnybone Toys Brings Back Ancient Game Play

DENVER - Funnybone Toys will debut one of the oldest games ever played at this year's American International Toy Fair: Funnybones.

Inspired by a classic game that was played for more 2,000 years—even as far back as ancient Greece and Rome—using real pieces of bone—the new version takes a modern twist.

Funnybone includes five Funnybone pieces, a canvas bag to hold them, and a six-inch chain, that can keep the Funnybone pieces together while learning the game moves. Recommended for ages 6 and up, the game features more than 30 challenges that increase in difficulty and incorporate the hand/eye coordination use of video games, improves dexterity and helps emphasize growth and development in the following skills: diligence, patience/taking turns, and hand/eye coordination.
